INTERNATIONAL JUSTICE MISSION (IJM) is a global organisation working to stop slavery and violence. Right now, 50 million people are trapped in slavery. 1 in 4 is a child – that's the equivalent of every child in England and Wales. IJM believe every person deserves freedom and justice. Their teams work with authorities and partners in 33 r egions across 18 countries to combat slavery, trafficking, violence against women and children, and police abuse of power. Our joint 10.30 service at St John's on Sunday 23rd February will focus on God's heart for justice and in particular how IJM are working to rescue and support victims of modern day slavery. Charmaine Marufu, from IJM's North of England team will be speaking to us.


