Our Year In Review 2024 at Artizan International



This year our Organics team have poured **1200 candles** and **800 lip balms!**
We have filled all the spaces in their timetable with a full team of talented “Chandlers”
We have provided favours for **3 weddings**, completed **2 corporate orders** and produced our first ever **Advent Calender!**

Our Year In Review 2024 at Artizan International



Donations from businesses and organisations in Peru have allowed us to replace 4 wheelchairs, prescription glasses and provided food baskets for our artisans and trainees at Christmas

Over 50 people have attended mosaic workshops at our centre in Peru and purchased mosaics from us

Artisans in Peru have created over 200 handmade products for their shop

We have delivered 20 youth club sessions to our young disabled adult community in Harrogate and surrounding areas

The group has grown in members by 70% this year

We will be increasing our social calendar next year so sign up for more information to join in as a member or to volunteer



Our amazing 18 artisans in Ecuador with support from the project leaders; Carlos and Jessie have made some beautiful products that we sell in the shop here in Harrogate. We have sold over 3,000 cards, over 1,000 bracelets, 900 earrings and nearly 400 Cushions.

There is no safety net in Ecuador and the artisans are living very different lives because of the training, support and income they receive, so thank you for your support
